

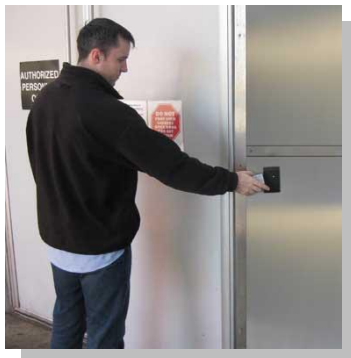

University benefits from integrated campus card, access control, and intelligent video solutions

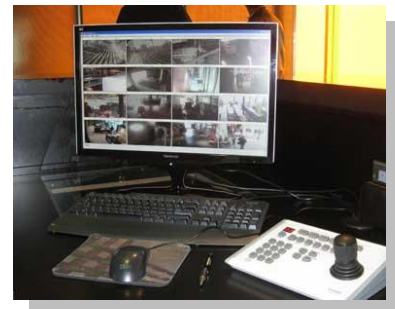
