Accessibility Roadmap

The development of an Accessibility Roadmap is essential for any organization who builds software where compliance to Accessibility standards is applicable. Generally, a roadmap is specific to a single application platform, which makes it different from a Statement of Direction which defines the Company's strategy for addressing accessibility compliance in its products.

The Roadmap is actually a bi-product of both the discovery/certification process which leads to creation of a VPAT 2.0 template and the backlog for items requiring remediation which is maintained by each development team at CBORD.

CBORD uses a standard Accessibility Roadmap template and the roadmap is updated every quarter for each individual product. Besides some basic information about the name and version of the product referenced, the template will also include the following detailed information which addresses any specific areas of the product that do not currently (and completely) conform to the AA standards outlined in Section 508 and WCAG 2.0:

- Accessibility Issue Description
- Current Status (Open, Closed, In Progress)
- Disposition (Planned, Deferred, In Progress)
- Remediation Time Line
- Available Workarounds
- Comments
